RULES & REGULATIONS

Welcome to the Tewa Owingeh Skate Spot

Please respect all rules & regulations for a safe & enjoyable skatepark.

Skateboarding, skating, and scootering is a hazardous recreational activity.
No supervision or staffing of the park is provided.

Open from sunrise to sunset unless otherwise noted.

Users of this park do so at his or her own risk and will be responsible for injuries and or damages.

1. This facility is for the enjoyment of skateboarders, scooters, roller skaters, and in-line skaters only. Bicycles and motorized vehicles are not permitted.
2. All participants must wear a helmet, knee, and elbow pads.
3. Guests under the age of 10 must be accompanied by and under the supervision of an adult at all times.
4. The park will be closed in rain or other unsafe conditions.
5. Use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or illegal substances are prohibited.
6. No food allowed in the skating area.
7. NO TRESPASSING when the park is closed.
8. No pets allowed on the skate equipment.
9. Graffiti, tagging, or defacing the park is not permitted. Violators will be prosecuted.
10. No person shall engage in verbal and/or physical assault. Violators will be prosecuted.
11. Threatening, bullying, or intimidating language or behavior is prohibited. Violators will be prosecuted.
12. Obscene language or acts are prohibited.
13. Adding ramps, jumps, or obstacles to the large ramp is prohibited.

Participants must follow park rules at all times.
Failure to follow these rules may result in closure of the park, prosecution, fines, or exclusion from park use.
